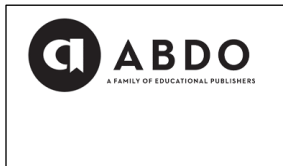
Reading Resources

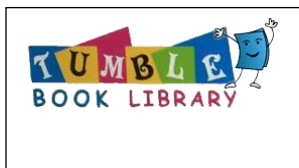

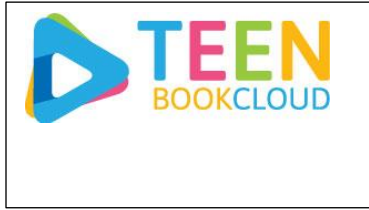

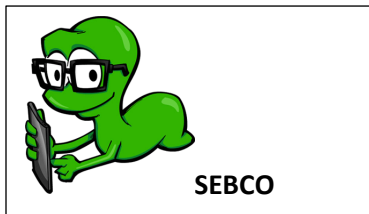
